 - Les téléphones sans fil qui utilisent le spectre 2.4 GHz peuvent affecter votre connexion au réseau maillé sans fil de façon négative.
 - Si vous remarquez un ralentissement ou une déconnexion lorsqu'une personne utilise un téléphone sans fil dans votre maison, c'est probablement ce téléphone qui vous cause des ennuis.

80th Anniversary Profile Percy Encil



Percy Encil was called up in 1940 for Basic Training with the Algonquin Regiment at North Bay, Ontario. In 1941 he joined up with the Algonquin Regiment and after a few months in North Bay, was transferred to the 24th Light Anti Aircraft

Battery in Sydney, Nova Scotia where they were protecting the steel mill. Percy also took a course in Artillery at Halifax, Small Arms in Long Branch and Chemical Warfare at Camp Borden, Ontario and earned his stripes as full Corporal.

Не w a s transferred to St. John's Newfoundland in late 1942 for about 5 months prior to leaving for Greenock, Scotland from Halifax in late 1943. From Scotland he was then sent to Aldershot, England to train before being shipped to France. Attached to the First Canadian Army late in 1944, they fought their way through France, Belgium and Holland and spent the winter in Nijmegen.

Percy's group went into Germany in early spring 1945 and ended up in Oldenburg, Germany. He earned his Sergeant's stripe. The war was over then and he returned to Appledorn, Holland where he transferred to the Army Service Corp

to transport vehicles that were purchased by the Polish Government. The vehicles were taken back to Oldenburg.


P e r c y remained in Germany until the end of April when he was sent back to England and on to Canada, arriving in May 1946.

Percy Encil has been a long time member of the Chapleau Legion and over many years has contributed greatly to Harry Searle Branch No. 5. Many will remember his annual visits to the hospital and schools in Chapleau as part of the Legion's Remembrance Day Services or as part of the Legion Colour Party in parades or at Legion functions.

Percy continues to play an important role in the Legion.
